Objectives and investment policy

Objective

The fund aims to provide capital and income growth over the long term.

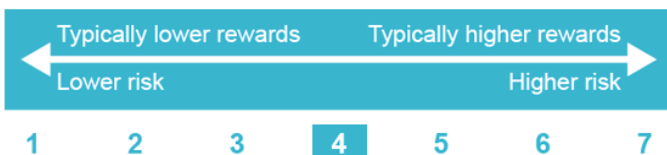
Investment Policy

The fund invests in the shares of UK and overseas companies, government and corporate debt securities. Assets which provide indirect exposure to gold and cash may also be held.

Essential features of the fund:

- The fund has the discretion to invest in a range of investments as described above with no need to adhere to a particular benchmark.
- The fund has no specific target market, asset class or geographic sector.
- You can buy and sell shares in the fund on each business day.
- Income from the fund will be added to the value of your investment.
- Currency hedging arrangements may be used to reduce the risk of currency movements in the value of overseas investments held by the fund.
- Recommendation: This fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.

Risk and reward profile



- This indicator shows how much a fund has risen and fallen in the past, and therefore how much a fund's returns have varied. It is a measure of a fund's volatility. The higher a fund's past volatility the higher the number on the scale and the greater the risk that investors in that fund may have made losses as well as gains. The lowest number on the scale does not mean that a fund is risk free.
- The fund has been classed as 4 because its volatility has been measured as average.
- This indicator is based on historical data and may not be a reliable indication of the future risk profile of this fund.
- The risk and reward profile shown is not guaranteed to remain the same and may shift over time.
- Credit Risk: Debt securities are affected by trends in interest rates and inflation. If interest rates go up the value of capital may fall and vice versa. Inflation will also decrease the real value of capital. The value of a debt security is also affected by its credit rating.

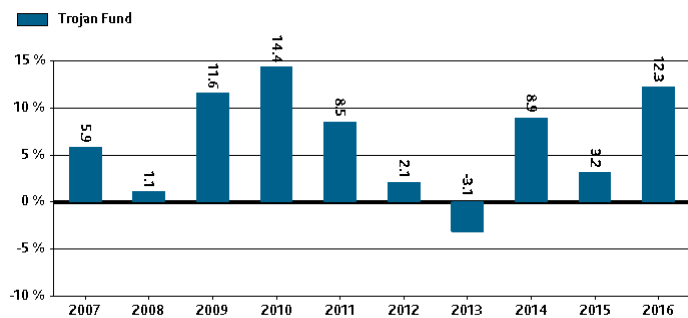
The entry charge shown is a maximum figure. In some cases investors may pay less. You can find out the actual charges from your financial advisor or distributor.
